After naming your beneficiary, you can also receive complimentary Child Safe kits, and a membership in AIL Plus, providing discounts on dental care, prescriptions, diabetic supplies, vision care and supplies and much more.

This coverage is provided through American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL), a 100% union company, serving union families like yours for more than 65 years. They currently have more than 290,000 IBEW members covered under AD&D policies and have paid over \$77.4 million in life, health and AD&D benefits to IBEW families.
